Recycling Policy Statement

Sea-Tech will develop the existing Environmental Policy by minimising the production of waste through sustainable purchasing practices and the reuse and recycling of materials.

Specific Aims:

- Develop a high level of awareness in relation to waste minimisation and recycling within our business operations
- Promote economy in the use of office consumables
- Encourage the purchase of recycled materials and those which are suitable for disposal by recycling
- Endeavour to appoint suppliers who remove packaging as part of their supply contract and who operate according to sound environmental practices and principles
- Minimise waste by encouraging the exchange and reuse of equipment and materials within our business operations
- Control activity when systems not in use (i.e., switch off at night)
- The setting, maintaining, and monitoring of Environmental SMART Objectives and KPI's that reflect Sea-Tech's activities.
- Ensuring environmental & recycling performance is monitored and the procedures, along with this policy are reviewed annually to ensure continual improvement.

In respect of communicating the Sea-Tech Minimisation & Recycling Policy it is the Senior Leaderships responsibility to ensure that it is made freely available to all stakeholders. A copy of this Environmental Policy is to be held in each office and work site location to continuously remind employees of the company's commitment to the environment.
